Star Search 2021 Dance Requirements

- 1. **Group dances** and **Solo Levels 3 & 4** should choose music that is meaningful to the group/person and has a positive or Christian message.
- 2. All dances should be no less than two minutes (2:00), and no more than four minutes (4:00).
- 3. Solo Levels 1-2 should perform to the music provided below.
- 4. All song selections and dances should be approved by your corps officer.
- 5. All choreography must be original.

Embrace the freedom and get creative!

- Utilize ANY style of music or dance.
- Play to your dancer(s) strengths.
- Utilize the unique culture of your corps participant(s).
- Any language is welcomed (Please provide lyrics in English for the adjudicators).
- Choreodramas are allowed. (A story told through movement).
- Lyrics are not required.

Star Search 2021 Solo Dance Song Selections

Level 1

Song: *Sparrows* by Cory Asbury

Album: To Love a Fool, track #2 - 3:17 mins

Style: Mid-tempo lyrical with a driving beat behind.

Rationale: The message of this song is that God always takes good care of us. The clear rhythm of this song will help younger dancers stay with the music while the words are a great message for us to hear.

Level 2

Song: *Into the Sea (It's Gonna Be OK)* by Tasha Layton **Album:** Into the Sea (It's Gonna Be OK) - Single, 3:02 mins

Style: Dramatic Lyrical

Rationale: This song starts quiet and then builds with a lot of drama. This will allow the dancer to show some vulnerable moments while displaying some of the larger movements that they enjoy. The theme of the song speaks to the phrase "it's gonna be ok" because God is with us, a theme we all need to be reminded of.

Level 3 & 4

Song: Choose your own music. Appropriate length is between 2:00-4:00minutes.

Style: Your choice!

Rationale: Dancers in level 3 & 4 understand what style of movement best suits their body and ability. Choose a piece of music that best displays what you do well that has a positive or Christian message.
